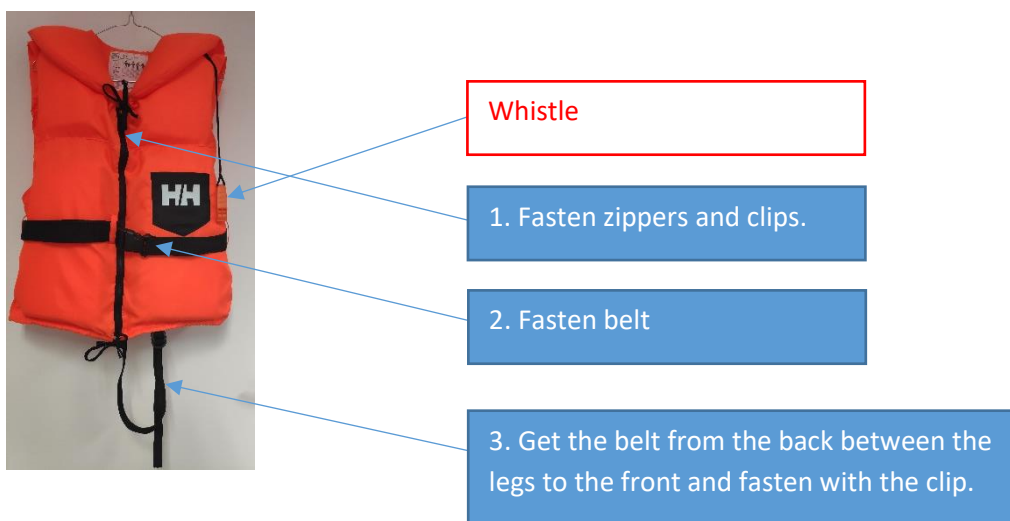
Rights and Obligations of the Captains

- It is obliged to carry passengers with professional care and to ensure safety and order on board.
- Holds the certificate of professional competence (license) of the captain of small boat.
- The captain has the right to cancel or postpone the cruise to an alternative date in case of force majeure: bad weather: rain, wind, fog, unfavourable water status (low, high water level), floating objects on rivers, cruising arrangements.
- The captain has the right to change embarking and disembarking points. E.g. unfavourable weather conditions, water status (low, high water level), occupation of boarding place or its other unavailability.

Life Jackets

- Each boat shall carry a life jacket for each passenger.
- Children under 15 are obliged to wear a life jacket aboard.
- Persons over 15 years of age are not required to wear a life jacket on board. In the event that such a person is interested in wearing a life jacket, he or she may inquire a life jacket from the crew of the boat or the captain.
- Life jacket wear procedure
 - a/ put the vest over your hands
 - b / zip the front of the vest (according to vest type)
 - c / fasten belt with clips between legs
 - d / fasten the belt clips around the waist

Liability and Insurance

- Clients enter the boat and sail on their own risk and are responsible for any damage caused to their own health or property.
- Clients take a full responsibility for their safety during the sailing, and undertake it at their own risk.
- In case of passenger/s minor 18 years old, an accompaniment of a person older than 18 years old is inevitable on board, who undertakes full responsibility of this/these person/people.
- People minor 18 years old, an accompaniment of a person older than 18 years old are inevitable to of age, who assumes full responsibility for this person, is obligatory.

Obligations of the Boat Operator

- The ship's operator is responsible for the boat's proper condition and technical capability.
- Captain of the boat is responsible to ensure that the boat will not endanger the smoothness and safety of its operations, the smoothness and safety of inland waterway traffic and the environment. The boat's operator may use the boat only for the purpose specified in the boat's certificate or in the certificate of small boat.
- The operation of small boats subject to registration may only be carried out by a natural person - a small boat's captain who holds a small craft proficiency certificate or a legal person through persons holding a small craft proficiency certificate, or an entrepreneur.

Obligations of the Passenger

- The passenger is obliged to familiarize himself with the "Small Craft Safety Manual / Safety Instructions" before embarking.
- In case of group of passengers, the client must demonstrably notify all members of the "Small Craft Safety Manual / Safety Instructions".
- Passengers are required to arrive at the agreed departure point 10 minutes before the agreed start of the cruise. In case of delay, the provider does not guarantee the length and performance of the cruise, which may be shortened by the delay time, or the cruise may be postpone to another date or time.
- Passengers may embark and disembark only when the boat is stationary and an entitled member of the crew allows to EMBARK or DISEMARK.
- To behave in a way that does not impact negatively the safe transport of other passengers, damage the equipment of the boat or the boat, not polluting the boat, environment and space for passengers and not disturbing other passengers and crew members.
- Obey these instructions and instructions of the captain or an entitled person or dispatcher to ensure its safety and the safety of other passengers or the safety and continuity of the

boat's operation. If a passenger does not respect these instructions, they may be excluded from the cruise. Such an exclusion from the cruise shall not be regarded as failure to provide the service by the captain and the travel agent.

- If requested by the captain of a small boat, take off shoes, before boarding the boat.
- Smoking on boat is forbidden.
- Be careful, take care of your own safety and refrain from anything that could endanger or limit the operation of the boat and the safety of people.
- Boarding out of port may only be warranted in justified cases on the instruction of the captain who will take care of the safety of the passengers.
- No diversion from the boat while cruising, as well as touching the surface of water.
- It is forbidden to move on the boat and stand during the cruise unless authorized by the captain.
- When inspecting a boat on a river, respect the officials.
- If the passenger causes damage to the carrier, it must be paid in full to the carrier.
